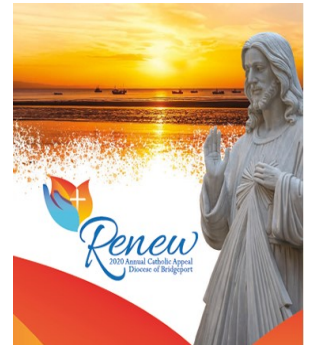


Wednesdays at 1:00pm
