A Brief History of Our Organ

Did you know...?

In 2001, Reverend Thomas P. Thorne, Pastor from 1999-2018, expressed a desire for a new pipe organ to replace the late nineteenth century Cole and Woodberry which had served the parish for over one hundred years. (Below)



Funds were quickly raised through the generosity of Assumption parishioners and a concert given by Jose Feliciano at the Levitt Pavilion. Donor names and memorials are displayed in the church vestibule. (Below)



The contract was given to Austin Organs of Hartford, Connecticut and renovations began. Four lancet windows facing Riverside Avenue were sealed off to accommodate the new instrument. New wood floors replaced carpeting and a music library was created in one of the church towers. (Below)





The Cole and Woodberry organ was dismantled and transported to St Patrick's Catholic Church in Newcastle, Maine where it was reassembled and restored. (Above)

Unfortunately, the original digital organ chimes installed in 2004 are no longer functioning.

We are currently seeking to replace them with authentic tubular chimes in the near future.
