## Our Lady of Peace and Good Voyage Statue



Dear Parishioners,

This past week our parish, the Filipino Community and the Diocese of Bridgeport received a special gift from the International Shrine of Our Lady of Peace and Good Voyage in Antipolo, Philippines. This blessing was brought to us by the rector of the Cathedral of the Diocese of Antipolo, Fr. Reynante Tolentino and Mr. Noel Reyes. This replica of the miraculous image of our Blessed Mother is a beautiful reminder for all of us the love of the Blessed Virgin Mary for her people. Our image is the fifth authentic replica around the world. The city of Valladolid Spain has one, two images are in Italy, one in Rome and the other is in Milan. There are two in the United States, one is at the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception, Washington DC, and the fifth is in our parish.

You might ask what is the story behind this image of Our Lady of Peace and Good Voyage or commonly called "Our Lady of Antipolo". The original image was brought by the Governor General Juan Nino de Tabora of Mexico via the Galleon El Almirante in 1626. His safe voyage across the Pacific Ocean was attributed to the image and it was named "Our Lady of Peace and Good Voyage". The statue crossed the Pacific Ocean six times before it became permanent at the Cathedral of the Diocese of Antipolo. There are so many reported miracles attributed to the original image and the devotion spread not just in the Philippines but all around the world. Once again we are so blessed by this gift.
