Serving: pasta, meatballs, stuffed breads, wine, coffee and pastry

The St. Joseph Table is an Old World devotion brought to the U.S. over a century ago by Italian immigrants. As the legend goes, there was a long drought and famine in Sicily. The people prayed to St. Joseph for relief and after a time, the skies opened up. The only crop to survive was the fava bean which saved them from starvation.

The traditional St. Joseph table is constructed in the shape of the Cross with three levels honoring the Holy Trinity. Foods of the Italian harvest are featured on the table: grapes, lemons, figs, olives, along with bread, wine, and specialty desserts. Additional symbols and statues remind us of the life of St. Joseph.

PLEASE COME TO HONOR THIS GREAT SAINT AND THE POWER OF HIS INTERCESSION THROUGHOUT THE AGES.




Alms Giving



The Season of Lent

What is Lent?

Lent is the 40-day period from Ash Wednesday and before Easter Sunday. It is marked by praying, fasting, abstinence, and other acts of penance.

What is Fasting?

Fasting is one meal a day, and two smaller meals which if added together would not exceed one full meal. Our Lenten sacrifice also includes not eating between meals.

Days of Fast?

There are only two days of Fast, Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. All Catholics between the age of 18 to 59 should observe this practice. Those with health issues are excused.

What is Abstinence?

This is a penitential practice consisting of refraining from eating meat and to be observed by all Catholics of 14 years of age and older. The days of abstinence are Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all of the Fridays during Lent.
