- Fr. Cyrus: Opened the meeting with a prayer.
- The minutes from the last meeting were accepted by Bill Macnamara and seconded by Tom Bonaventura.
- **Fr. Cyrus**: Outlined the two training sessions for new global synod Ambassadors Orientation which will be held on October 16<sup>th</sup>. at St. Francis Church in Weston, CT: Michele Harding, Mary Welch-Leman, Craig Wile, Michael Rafferty are our representatives.

**The Paradisus Dei Training**: (Invitation to Ministry for Young Families). Father will invite young families to a meeting on October 27, at 7:00pm at St John Church in Darien.

**Father Cyrus**: also spoke about another initiative the bishop wants to implement, Young Catholic Professionals along with older professionals to act as board members.

**Father Cyrus**: is inviting the parish to see the newly renovated McGrath Hall after all the Masses on the weekend of October 16, 17.
